Activities overview



Our dedicated centre manager and qualified staff prioritise children's safety and happiness, overseeing daily educational and recreational activities. Our clubs cater to a variety of interests, providing diverse experiences.

Children participate in social activities, learning fascinating facts, and playing games such as Connect 4, magnetic colour and number maze, LCD writing tablet, colouring activity sheets, Jenga, marble run, puzzles, and clay. They also engage in circle activities. Creativity is nurtured through mask-making, creating LEGO models, and storytelling. Physical activities encompass ball games, air floating hover football, flying air ball, badminton, table tennis, water balloon, and team sports, promoting balance and coordination. Educational exploration includes learning languages, global toys, and educational computer games. Entertainment and relaxation options feature board games, tabletop activities, slime sensory activities for texture and sensation experiences, constellation sensory ball, sensory liquid timer, sensory loom bands, fishing game, puzzles with numbers and letters, international recipes, gardening, movies, and music sessions for talent showcases.

Food Offer

Breakfast Club offers a delightful and varied morning menu. Options include toast with honey and jam, a selection of cereals with a choice of warm or cold milk, waffles (on Tuesdays), croissants (on Wednesdays), and pancakes (on Thursdays).

Additionally, yoghurt and a variety of fruits are available to provide a wholesome and satisfying start to the day.

After School Club provides a diverse range of snacks, with water readily available at all times. Options include beans on toast or chicken wraps, chicken sausage, bagels with cheese, wholegrain sandwich slices, rice cakes, crackers with cheese, and plain bread with the choice of butter or jam. Additionally, there are hoops, fresh vegetables, and fruits for a well-rounded selection.

Collection Time

Breakfast Club: At the end of our morning session, we escort Nursery, Reception, and Year 1 children to their classrooms. Year 2, 3, and 4 children are guided to their teachers in the playground, while Year 5 and 6 children proceed to their classrooms on their own.

After School Club: Our staff gathers the children from their classes before our afternoon session commences.
