



ARTS & CRAFTS Make trapeze artists with straws, paper, wool/string, scissors, glue, and pens/pencils

OUTDOOR / INDOOR PLAY Music statues | Human Knot | Multi Sports/Competition Games

Human Knot:

- 1. Ask five to eight children to volunteer or create small groups of the same number.
- 2. Have the children sit together in a tight circle, touching their shoulders and legs.
- 3. Ask all the participants to put their hands in the middle. Then, each child should carefully grab the wrist of another player in the group.
- 4. Once the children form the knot, ask them to gently and considerately untangle themselves without letting go.
- 5. This process will require strategy and communication. If necessary, a child can briefly let go of a wrist to untangle but should immediately grab the same wrist again.
- 6. To make this game a bit more challenging, ask participants to communicate without words.
