Activities Overview



Our dedicated centre manager and staff prioritise our children’s well-being and growth by providing daily educational and recreational activities.

Our club ensures we cater to diverse interests by offering various activities. To promote teamwork values and coordination, we offer sports activities such as ball games.

Nurturing creativity and self-expression is done through arts and crafts activities ranging from playdough and clay to colouring, as well as storytelling and role-playing.

Educational enhancement involves reading about and celebrating different cultures on top of homework, ICT, and language support. For social activities, we enjoy our Just Dance sessions, musical chairs, board games, and construction club. A quiet corner is provided to support our early years.

Food Offer

Monday: Toast, beans, cheese, butter, crackers, tomatoes, cucumbers, apples, bananas, yoghurt, and water.
 Tuesday: Wrap, lettuce, chicken, rice, cake, grapes, oranges, carrots, hummus, milk, and water.
 Wednesday: Bagel, cheese, jam, crackers, cheese, spread, apples, oranges, cucumber, lettuce, water, milk, and hot chocolate.
 Thursday: Pita, corn cakes, sandwich, chicken, cucumber, hummus, carrots, banana, mango, yoghurt, and water.
 Friday: Toast, jam or honey, cheese, tomato or chicken soup, cucumber, carrots, apples, grapes, milk, and water.

We cater to all dietary requirements and food options vary.

Collection Time

Breakfast Club: At the end of our morning session, we escort Nursery, Reception, and Year 1 children to their classrooms. Year 2, 3, and 4 children are guided to their teachers in the playground, while Year 5 and 6 children proceed to their classrooms on their own.

After School Club: Our staff gathers the children from their classes before our afternoon session commences.
