Activities overview



Our dedicated centre manager and qualified staff prioritise children's safety and happiness, overseeing daily educational and recreational activities.

Our clubs cater to a variety of interests, providing diverse experiences. Children participate in social activities, learning, fun, playing games, and taking part in hall games. Creativity is nurtured through arts and crafts using different mediums, including paint, modelling clay, and colouring. We also offer small-world play and books.

Physical activities include ball games, parachute games, and team sports, promoting balance and coordination. Entertainment and relaxation options feature board games, tabletop activities, slime sensory activities for texture and sensation experiences, and beading and loom bands. At Sudbourne, we plan our activities around the children's interests, and for the EYFS children, we try to link in with activities involving what they are learning about in class.

Food Offer

Breakfast Club offers a delightful and varied morning menu. Options include toast with honey and jam, a selection of cereals with a choice of warm or cold milk, We also have pancakes and crumpets available on different days.

Fruits are available to provide a wholesome and satisfying start to the day.

After School Club provides a diverse range of snacks, with water readily available at all times. Options: wraps, rice cakes, crackers with cheese, honey and hummus. Additionally, fresh vegetables, and fruits for a well-rounded selection.

Collection Time

Breakfast Club: At the end of our morning session, we escort Nursery, Reception, and Year 1 children to their teachers. Year 2 and upwards children are guided to their teachers in the playground.

After School Club: Nursery and years 1-2 are collected from their classrooms and years 3 - 6 are escorted over the studio by school staff.

The designated collection period for parents and collectors is from 17:10 to 18:00.
